### **Directions to Work Point, CFB Esquimalt.**

- **To Work Point from Downtown Victoria:**  
Cross the Johnson Street Bridge (the blue bridge) westbound towards Vic West and Esquimalt. Once you cross the bridge you will be on Esquimalt Road. Turn left, toward the ocean, onto Head Street, just after the Tim Horton's. Be sure to make a left to continue on Head St at the bottom of the hill, where Head intersects with Gore Street. Work Point is one block further. (1.8 miles or 3km). The training will take place in the **Collier NABS Building**. **Parking will be located in the large lot immediately after you enter the base.** Signs within Work Point will direct you towards the buildings.
